We do not collect personally identifying information about you when you visit our Web site, unless you choose to provide such information to us. Providing such information is strictly voluntary.

We take no responsibility for, and exercise no control over, the organizations, views, or accuracy of the information contained on other servers. 2. Use of Text and Images

If you would like to publish information that you find on our Web site, please attribute credit to PRC. Where text or images are posted on our site with the permission of the original copyright holder, a credit appears on the page. 3. Accessibility

4. Children's Privacy

In compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), we do not solicit personal information from children. Visitors twelve years of age and under should remember that they are required to obtain an adult's permission before submitting any personal information to any Web site.

5. Collection of Information

We collect and store only the following information about you via our Web site: the name of the domain from which you access the Internet (for example, aol.com, if you are connecting from an America Online account, or princeton.edu if you are connecting from Princeton University's domain), the date and time you access our site, and the Internet address of the Web site from which you linked to our site. We will not obtain personally identifying information about you when you visit our site, unless you choose to provide such information to us. Providing such information is strictly voluntary.

6. How Your Information May Be Used

We use the information we collect to measure the number of visitors to the different sections of our site, and to help us make our site more useful to visitors. If you voluntarily share your personally identifying information to update your profile, make a donation online, or send a question or comment via electronic email, we may use this information to respond to your inquiry, update your contact information in our database, or provide you with more targeted content that may be of interest to you. We use personally identifying information primarily to respond to your requests. You may always opt-out of receiving future communications; see the "Opt-Out" section below.

7. Disclosure of Personal Information

Except as might be required by law, we do not share any personal identifying information we receive with any outside parties. We may share aggregated demographic information with funders and other organizations, but this aggregate information is not linked to any personal information that can identify any individual person. We will not share, trade, or sell your personal information or email address with any outside parties, unless specifically authorized by the user for a specific purpose.

8. Opt-Out or Change Your Contact Information

Our electronic communications provide users the opportunity to opt-out of receiving communications from us. You may choose to receive only specific communications or none at all. You may also update your contact information previously provided to us through another online form. You cannot remove yourself from our database, but you can prevent unwanted communication.
